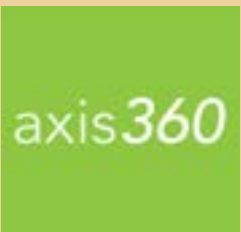
Comics Plus gives instant access to thousands of manga, comic books and graphic novels. The Library Pass app is available for Android and iOS, or visit the Comics Plus website.
