Accessing Your Account

Visit sgpl.org and click 'My Account' or 'catalog' to access your account. To log in, enter your library card number and your **PIN**, the last four digits of your library card number.

Once logged in you can see your checkouts, renew items, manage your holds, and pay fines and fees any time.
